



Sixth Form Dress Code

Sixth form are required to wear formal business wear. Smart tailored skirt, trousers or dress are all acceptable and must be worn with a jacket.

Our varied and extensive careers and speakers programmes mean that sixth form are frequently meeting with a wide range of professionals.

Not only does your smart dress set an example to the rest of the school, it also ensures you are ready for any networking opportunity.

We actively encourage sixth form girls to develop their own vision of what it means to be a confident woman in the workplace and we trust girls to choose outfits which are formal and appropriate.

To help you we have the following guidelines:

No:

Hats or hair covering (other than hijab or equivalent religious headscarf)
Leggings
Jeans
Skinny rather than slim fit trousers
Shorts
Play-suits
Very short skirts (shorter than mid-way between knee and hip)
'Body-con' dresses or skirts
Trainers
Flip-flops
Dr Marten boots or equivalent

- Hair should be of a natural style and colour. No visible tattoos are allowed. Single ear piercings are permitted. Discreet make-up and nail varnish is permitted.

Should girls fail to meet the standards of appropriate business dress the following procedure will be followed:

Stage 1 - You will be advised the outfit is inappropriate and asked not to wear it again. This will be recorded and shared with the Sixth Form Team. Any questions over suitability will be passed to the Head of Sixth Form.

Stage 2 – Should you come into school in an inappropriate outfit on a second occasion, this will also be recorded and parents will be called by the Sixth Form Team.

Stage 3 – Should you still fail to wear appropriate business wear, parents will be called and you will be asked either:

- to return home if it is possible for you to do so and return within 1 hour;
- or, you will be internally excluded for the day.

Stage 3 can be repeated if required, but repeat offence could result in a girl being seen to have failed to meet the terms of the Home-School Agreement.
